2. Organizational Context

Building with Nature (BwN) is an innovative infrastructure development approach that addresses the root causes of problems and balances the sustainable functioning of ecosystems on the one hand with the demand for development and use on the other. Also in Indonesia Building with Nature has been introduced, with the aim to achieve a paradigm shift towards sustainable hydraulic engineering. As such we offer a holistic and integrated, landscape scale systems approach to coastal zone, lake and river management, while addressing climate change adaptation and mitigation, disaster risk reduction, biodiversity goals, human welfare and sustainable economic development, in line with Agenda 2030.

The currently existing BwN Indonesia webpage is managed by Ecoshape, as part of the overall international Ecoshape website: www.ecoshape.org, which also showcases the Building with Nature philosophy, design guidelines and all existing Building with Nature pilots. To boost BwN replication and scaling up, and eventually institutionalise BwN across Indonesia and the surrounding regions, it was decided to develop a separate Building with Nature website for Indonesia and SEA region.

The website will be managed by the BwN Secretariat run by the BwN Indonesia Consortium, which will over time develop into an independent BwN Platform with a wider group of public and private sector members and BwN champions. Initially, the chief of the platform will also lead and maintain the website – to be gradually handed over to the Ministry of Marine Affairs and Fisheries (Kementerian Kelautan dan Perikanan - KKP). The current partners contributing to the website include representatives of the BwN Secretariat and the BwN Indonesia Consortium. The two main government partners of BwN Indonesia are the Ministry of Marine Affairs and Fisheries (Kementerian Kelautan dan Perikanan) and the Ministry of Public Works and Housing (Kementerian Pekerjaan Umum dan Perumahan Rakyat). The website will be hosted by the Ministry of Marine Affairs and Fisheries and can be linked to (mothered under) the KKP website, for instance: kkp.go.id/membangunbersamaalam. This way, home of the website can be in KKP office. It is important that the development process of the website incorporates KKP's views.

Purposes of the website: The website will become a platform for all Building with Nature information exchange in Indonesia and the wider South East Asia region (such as Vietnam, Malaysia), including: best practices, knowledge and experience, and resource/ potential mapping. It will:

- Express the ambition to institutionalise BwN as a new design philosophy in Indonesia to achieve a paradigm shift towards sustainable hydraulic engineering
- Hub for information on Building with Nature approach, potential and applications
- Showcase initiatives, achievements, best practices, and success stories in Indonesia
- Hub for news, events, and knowledge on BwN and developments (science, policy, practice, finance) relevant to BwN
- Platform for resource/ potential mapping in the context of matching in-coming work proposals from the regions with potential/ available funding sources, e.g. from donors (ADB, IBRD, country-based AID, etc.) and other parties
- Function as helpdesk
- Contribution, donations, membership

Target audience:

The target audience for the websites include professionals from the public and private sector in Indonesia and surrounding regions (initially South east Asia) responsible for hydraulic engineering. These include government ministries/agencies, contractors, engineering companies, donors (international like ADB and IBRD and country-based AID, etc.) academia, non-government organisations (NGOs), and international development. In addition, it should be accessible for the general public to get a basic understanding of the BwN approach and the activities in Indonesia. The websites will be a means of communicating the BwN solutions i.e. pilot implementation, knowledge, and policy interventions. They will also serve as portals to all the BwN Project Partners websites.

The Web Developer will be responsible for developing a website, maintaining it for 18 months and providing training on content management to the project partner representatives.

4. Scope of Work

The consultant will work under the supervision of the Policy, Advocacy, Communications Coordinator of Wetlands International Indonesia and chief of the BwN platform on website development, functionality, content, and training. S/he will perform the following duties:

 Develop sitemap, wireframes, web templates, prototypes and websites using the latest front-end technologies.

- Assist in updating application of development policies to ensure that all future applications meet the latest technical requirements.
